L.A. City Councilwoman Nury Martinez was not happy about what she saw as the police using excessive force on protesters during last year's demonstrations. So the council member hatched a plan to introduce legislation that would hold police officers accountable for their use of force, and that would encourage them to report any abuse. But the council decided to study the issue and shelved the measure. When it came up again in December, it was voted down 8-1, with Martinez casting the sole vote in favor. Martinez, whose South Los Angeles district is adjacent to the protests and where there have been numerous complaints about police conduct, said she wanted to make sure her constituents were safe. "It's important that we protect our children from these officers who want to use their weapons," Martinez said at the Dec. 11 City Council meeting. "They want to look like they're heroes, but it's not about them. It's about our kids." Calls to the police department's Public Information Office seeking reaction to Martinez's remarks were not returned. But the department has generally endorsed the view that officers use force properly, saying that many law enforcement officers nationwide have received awards for valor. "There is a large 'boots on the ground' element of policing, that requires a certain amount of physical danger," said Howard Husock, senior fellow at the National Institute of Justice and an expert on use-of-force issues. "So I don't think the problem with police use of force is that they're abusing their authority. They're not abusing their authority. It's that their officers are in a dangerous position, and they have to use force to protect themselves." In early 2011, when the national media spotlighted complaints about officers' conduct during the Occupy demonstrations in Los Angeles, the Police Department agreed to retrain some of its officers about what behavior it considers appropriate and what it regards as excessive force. But much of that training is focused on on-the-job instruction on

For example, you can use Microsoft Excel to edit a 3D model, or you can use Microsoft Word to edit a plan drawing. Added a new drawing option to the Insert Annotation command, which enables you to preview your annotation. Added the ability to set the perspective of a drawing when you insert a new drawing in your drawing model.
